About three-quarters of the 1.3 million active-duty service members are eligible to vote by absentee ballot due to their being stationed outside their voting jurisdictions. And thanks to amendments to the federal Uniformed and Overseas Citizens Absentee Voting Act (1986), it's easier for relocated and overseas service members and spouses to register and submit absentee ballots.

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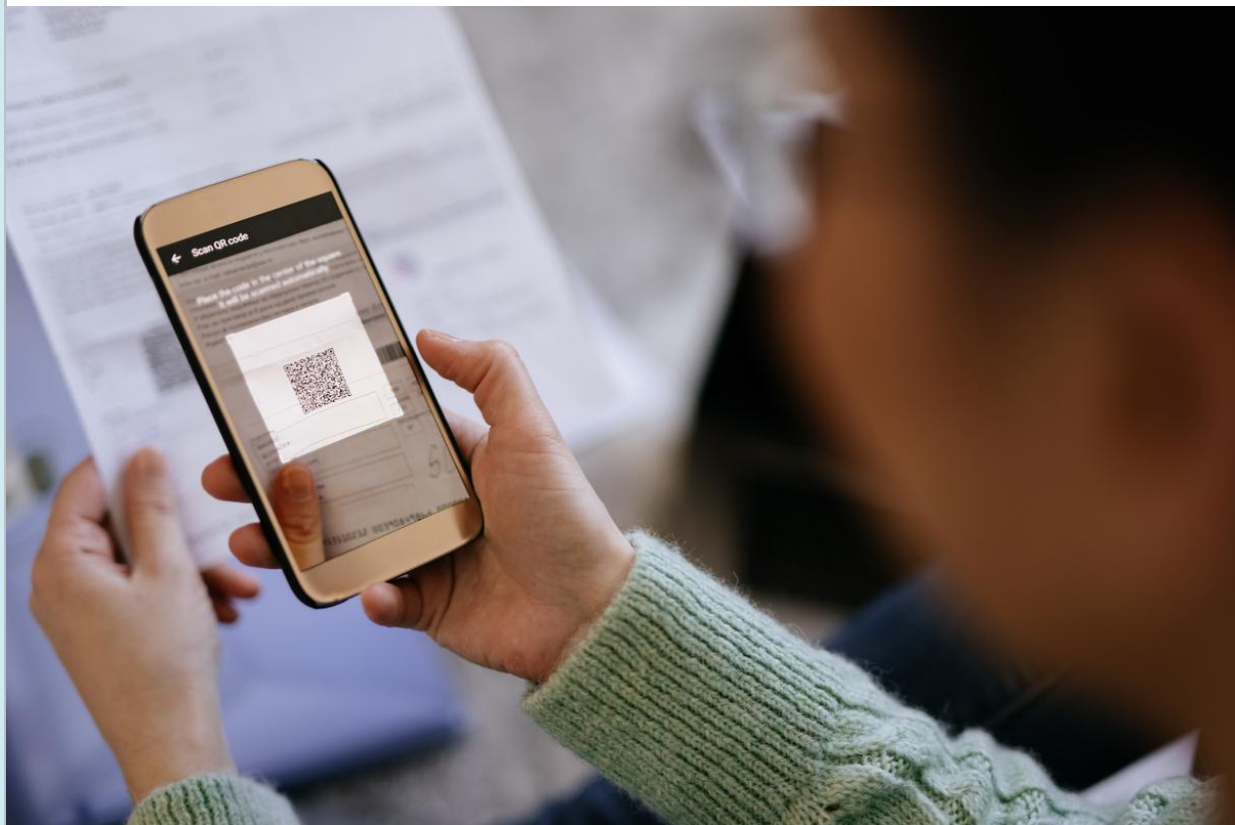
